- Rule Governing the Prescribing of Opioids for Pain by the Agency of Human Services Emergency Rule;
 - Emergency granted by Deputy Secretary of Administration on July 6, 2017.
- Presentation of the following proposed rules:
 - 1. Private Stocking of Fish in Public and Private Waters, Agency of Natural Resources, Dept. of Fish and Wildlife
 - a. This Commissioner's Rule is required by 10 V.S.A. §4605 (c), and establishes guidelines by which the public may stock fish in private ponds and public waters. Only brook, brown and rainbow trout may be stocked into private ponds without a permit provided no more than 4,000 fish are stocked in a calendar year. A permit is required for stockings of greater than 4,000 brook, brown or rainbow trout into private waters, or stockings of any number of trout in public waters. No other fish species may be stocked by the public.
 - 2. Health Care Stop Loss Insurance (H-2009-02), Dept. of Financial Regulation
 - a. These amendments remove the per-employee dollar-amount provision governing minimum aggregate attachment points (§ 4 (A) (b) (i)), clarify the amendment's effective date, and require DFR to commission an actuarial study of appropriate attachment points every three years.
 - 3. Vermont Appliance Efficiency and Water Conservation Standards, Dept. of Public Service
 - a. This rule will implement in Vermont, as a matter of state law, the federal appliance efficiency and water conservation standards currently in effect pursuant to 10 C.F.R. Parts 430 and 431 only if and when those federal regulations are repealed or declared void. These federal standards have been in place for over 25 years.
